Overview

The development will include:

- 434 new homes
- 347 private / 33 affordable rent / 54 shared ownership homes
- A range of housing types including houses
- 346 on-site parking spaces
- Electric vehicle charging & car club access
- 8500+ sqm of outdoor amenity space
- Shared courtyard amenity space
- Connectivity to the Missing Links cycle route

Site activity

- Construction of the first block (Building C) at Ambia, St Cloud Way, Maidenhead is well underway, with the concrete frame, brickwork and windows complete.
- Private sales launched on site in August 2024.
- A new sales and marketing suite has opened on the ground floor of Block C.
- Improvements to the existing subway have been made to improve the journey to the town centre.

- First Occupations December 2024
- First Affordable Homes Delivered April 2025
- Block C completion December 2025
