We're excited to share an update on our development, along with what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

South Oxhey Central is currently in its third and final phase of construction, having delivered over 300 homes in this phase alone. Phase 3 is delivering:

- A total of 345 homes over 4.76 ha
- 19,790sqft retail and commercial space including a Lidl, pharmacy, cafes and a beauty salon.
- Landscaped podiums for residents

In addition to c.£1.4m of contributions to improvements in education, healthcare & library facilities across the overall scheme.

- Bridlington Road and Tom Lake Way roadworks complete and now open to the public.
- Hard landscaping to external car park outside of Hunter House is in progress.

Site Activity

- Final phase of construction progressing smoothly, with targeted completion by December 2024.
- Hunter House was completed in September 2024.
- Primary focus of the site team is now on the internal finishes and delivering the retail units on the ground floor ready to market and lease.

Station Approach

- Station Approach public area is complete. Street lighting has been provided, and we are currently working with our contractors to install additional sockets to allow for light fixtures (i.e. Christmas lights).
- New planting in all the planters and crocuses on the grass mounds.
- Regular maintenance teams on site to ensure upkeep of the area.

Timeline

- Sales and Marketing Suite continues to be operational at South Oxhey Central Marketing Suite 1 on Station Approach.
- 1-bed and 2-bed units available for purchase in Thompson House.
- The final commercial units are now under construction and are available to lease from November 2024.
- It is anticipated that construction across South Oxhey will be completed by December 2024.
