We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

This development will include:

- 408 new homes
- A range of 2, 3 & 4-bedroom homes
- A mix of terraced, semi-detached and detached homes
- Play area and open green space
- Whinny Brook

Site activity

- Whinny Brook landscaping establishment
- Phase 2 construction has commenced
- Roads and sewers construction for phase 2 to begin
- Whinny Brook Remedial work to commence and be completed Spring 2025.

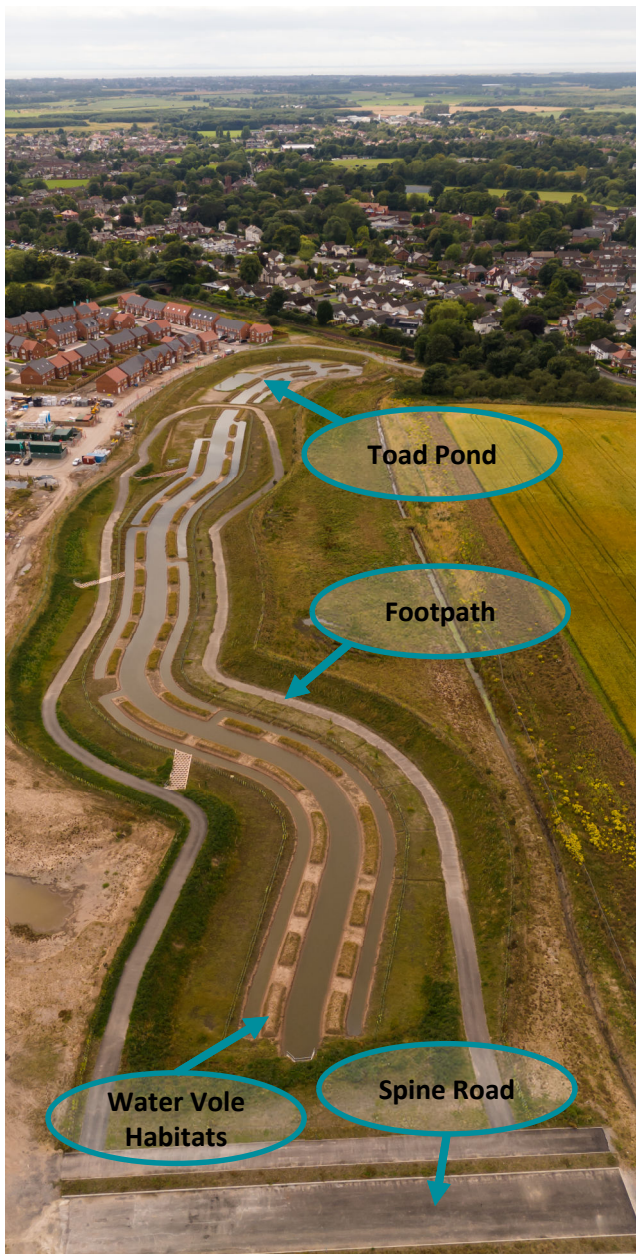
Phase 2

The first handovers of phase two completed prior to Christmas! Construction is ongoing for phase 2.

Designs for the spine road connecting Poverty Lane to School Lane are currently awaiting approval, which is anticipated to be opened in Summer 2026.

Timeline

- All Phase 1 homes are sold and occupied.
- The first phase 2 plots completed prior to Christmas 2024. The whole phase comprises an extra 124 homes which is anticipated to take 18-24 months to complete.
- The roads and sewers are complete for phase 1 of the development. Further work will be carried out during the adoption of the roads and footpaths aligning to Sefton Council's requirements.
- The works along Poverty Lane will commence following approval from the Council. This includes formation of the permanent bus stops and speed bumps.
- Whinny Brook's construction and landscaping planting is complete.
- Whinny Brook remedial work to be complete Spring 2025.
- Water Voles (a protected species) to be released back into the brook Spring 2025.
- Show Homes are re-open for phase 2's homes.

Whinny Brook's remedial work is to take place for completion Spring 2025.

The brook's landscaping is currently establishing. Once the brook is fully established, we will be able to reintroduce the water voles, a protected species, back into the brook. The release is anticipated for Spring 2025.

Services

The services (gas, water and electric) are complete for phase 1 of the development, which includes 125 units. Phase 2 works have begun.

Care Home – Liberty

Liberty have been granted planning permission to build a care home on the scheme, located at the front of the development on Poverty Lane.

Piling Works

It is anticipated Trustgreen will be managing Whinny Brook from Summer 2025.

They will be managing the open space, play area (once installed) and Whinny Brook.
